Thank you for booking a trade plot at Volksfest Wales.

Please read the following carefully. By booking a trade pitch you are agreeing to the following:

- Trade pitches will be allocated on arrival to the festival site.
- Traders are responsible for their personal safety and security of their belongings, goods, vehicles and trade stand we strongly advise that all traders carry an appropriate fire extinguisher.
- Traders need to provide their own **diesel** generators, no hook ups or generators will be provided on site.
- Traders must ensure they leave a safe distance between neighbouring traders.
- There is no electricity on site. All fuel brought in must be held in the proper container and all generators must have at least one appropriate fire extinguisher. Generators must only be used during trading hours due to environmental health restrictions.
- All traders must carry Public Liability Insurance to the required cover (£1m) and if serving food or drink must also provide a copy of their Food Safety certificate. Note – copies of the above are required upon booking.
- No vehicular movement is allowed whilst the show is open to the public.
- No entry onto the site between 11pm and 8am.
- Sub letting of trade space is strictly prohibited.
- The sale or use of fireworks, sky lanterns, firearms, quad bikes, motorised scooters, motorised skateboards, motor bikes (of any size) is strictly prohibited. Also strictly prohibited is the sale of Nitrous Oxide and similar gasses/chemicals.
- The selling of food and drink (other than by designated caterers) is strictly prohibited. The sale of alcohol is prohibited to all traders as this is being handled by one licensed trader.
- Trade plots must be left clear, clean and tidy by no later than 8.00pm on the Sunday. Traders are responsible for removing all their trade waste by putting it in the skip provided or leaving it in black bags on the edge of the pitch to be collected.
- All accidents must be reported to the Information Centre.
- The person/s booking the trade plot will be held solely responsible for the behaviour of any person associated with them. Camping is allowed on your stand but the camping and site regulations must be adhered to.
